- This would be an <u>ontology-based</u> registry—with a web interface, and perhaps also a service interface that would allow members of the community to add information about their educational and training initiatives which are ontology-centered
- The system interface/s would provide the community with dynamic—and hopefully current—answers to a variety of queries and also with access to shared educational and training resources
