- May-2006 DaveFerrucci from IBM presented UIMA, and in Feb-2011, IBM's Watson defeated the all-time best Jeopardy players on TV
- OntologySummit2010 our Delphi study indicated that Ontology and its applications is likely to become mainstream in 5 to 10 years (wrt Q1/2010)
