ISO-15926, PSL, SUMO, ...

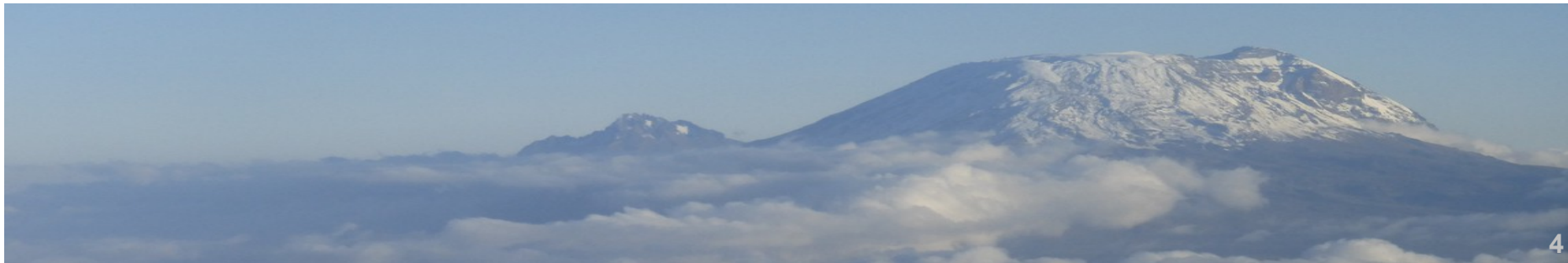


... but no, the Heidelberg meeting of 1998 was really the “first” Ontology Summit
